NILU is inviting expressions of interest from a neurodivergent-affirming learning facilitator to support our Nature Nurture sessions for home-educated children.

Sessions will be held within our new geodome at Badgers Cross, Gulval, with opportunities to utilise the surrounding land and natural environment as part of the learning experience.

This is not a traditional teaching role.

The work centres on connection, curiosity, regulation and relationship, creating opportunities for children to explore, create and learn through hands-on experiences, nature connection and child-led discovery.

We're looking for someone who can bring ideas, follow children's interests, and help create a space where learning emerges naturally.

About the Nature Nurture Sessions

- Small group learning environment

- Based in our geodome learning space at Badgers Cross, Gulval
- Opportunities for both indoor and outdoor learning
- Access to the surrounding land for nature-based activities
- Focus on connection, curiosity and wellbeing
- Child-led and responsive approach
- Space for children to learn through exploration, creativity and experience

Sessions may include:

- Nature crafts
- Gardening and growing projects
- Forest school-inspired activities
- Bushcraft and practical outdoor skills
- Wildlife and seasonal learning
- Permaculture principles
- Storytelling and imaginative play
- Silent disco activities and movement
- Dungeons & Dragons or other collaborative games

We are also open to new ideas and interests that you may bring.

Age range: 6–12 years

Hourly Rate: £25 per hour

Time commitment: One 2-hour session each Tuesday during term time

Experience supporting children with sensory sensitivities, anxiety, or complex nervous systems is highly desirable.

We're looking for a facilitator who:

- Has experience working with children in outdoor or alternative learning environments
- Has experience with neurodivergent children (professional and/or lived)
- Can create engaging, flexible learning experiences
- Is comfortable following children's interests rather than delivering a fixed curriculum
- Understands nervous system regulation and sensory needs
- Brings warmth, creativity and curiosity to their work
- Can adapt moment-to-moment and respond to the needs of the group

Relevant qualifications are important, but **attunement, pacing and relational skill are essential.**
