It is a space for **movement, rhythm, expression and regulation**, where children receive learning through embodied experience rather than instruction.

About the movement space

- Small group, relational setting
- Child-led and sensory-aware
- Space for movement, stillness, rhythm and expression
- No choreography, no performance expectations

Age range: 6 to 12

Hourly Rate: £25+ per hour

Time commitment: 2 hours per week

We're looking for a facilitator who:

- Has experience facilitating dance or movement with children
- Has experience with neurodivergent children (professional and/or lived)
- Is comfortable holding open-ended, flexible spaces
- Understands consent, regulation and sensory needs
- Values relationship and safety over outcomes

Formal training is welcome, **presence and adaptability are essential.**
